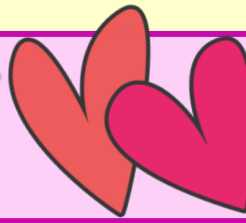

Family Book Night!

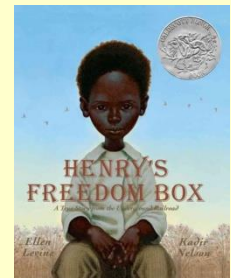
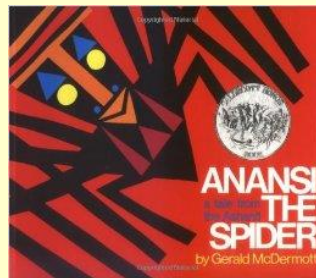
Family book night was a great success! Thank you to everyone who participated! We are looking forward to do it again in May!

7. Anansi The Spider by Gerald McDermott



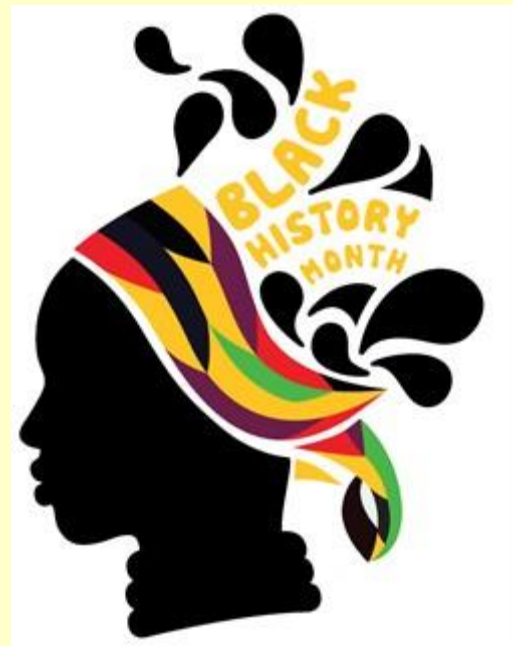
Thinking About Summer Yet?
