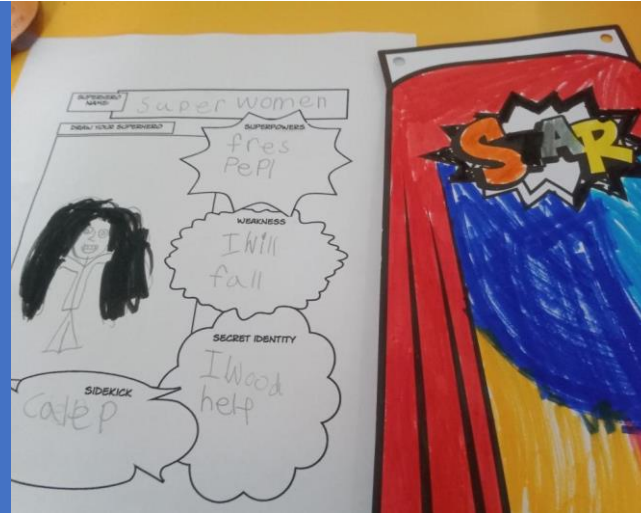
# Week 2 was all about Superheroes!

If I were a superhero I would. . .

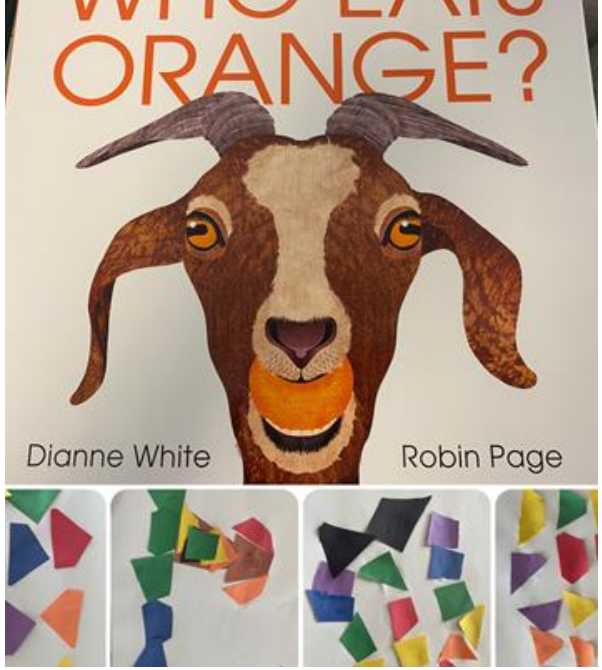

BELOW: The Hula Hoop contest was so much fun! Everybody lost count and just had a good time!

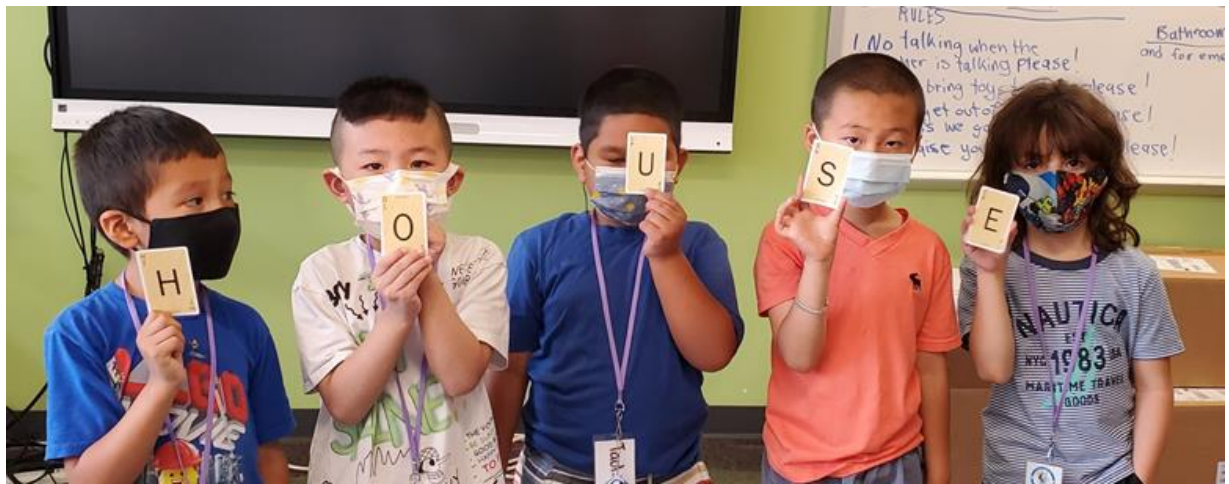


ABOVE: A group of our Kinder students read this book and did a rainbow activity at the end. What color do you eat?
